



MBA in International Management New Regulations (including short courses)

November 2009: Correction to the 2010 Regulations

Students are asked to note that there has been a correction to the wording of paragraphs 2.12 and 8.5 of the Programme Regulations for the MBA in International Management (New regulations) and a correction to the wording of paragraph 2.2 of the Programme Regulations for Short Courses. The below information supersedes the information currently provided in the 2010 Programme Regulations.

The correct wording should read:

Programme Regulations

2.12 Students registered for the following programmes may be permitted to transfer their registration to the MBA degree in International Management under these New Regulations:

- Postgraduate Diploma in International Management
- MSc degree in International Management
- Postgraduate Diploma in International Business
- MSc degree in International Business

Students registered for the MBA degree in International Management (Old regulations) and students registered for the MBA degree in International Management (Transitional regulations) will not be permitted to transfer their registration to the MBA in International Management (New regulations).

8.5 Students who transfer from the MSc degree, Postgraduate Diploma or Postgraduate Certificate in International Management to the MBA degree in International Management will be required to pay the remaining balance of the registration fee and the relevant course fees for the completion of the degree.

Programme Regulations for Short Courses

2.2 Students may take up **four** courses as short courses (see also paragraph 2.2 of the Short Course General Regulations).
